### **PARTICIPANTS**

Entries for the FINA Swimming World Cup 2013 - Moscow, Russia meet will only be accepted from national Federations affiliated to FINA. National Federations may choose to send a National Team or a Club Representative, not both.

### **ENTRY PROCESS & PROTOCOL**

#### **Preliminary Entry Form**

Should you wish to compete at the FINA Swimming World Cup 2013 – Moscow, Russia, please return your Preliminary Entry Form to The Russian Swimming

Federation no later than August 26, 2013. Preliminary Entries must include the following:

- The number of male swimmers attending the meet.
- The number of female swimmers attending the meet.
- The number of male officials being sent by that National Federation.
- The number of female officials being sent by that National Federation.

Upon receiving the Preliminary Entry Form, The Russian Swimming Federation will send a detailed information pack to the National Federation to compete at the event.

### **FINA Named Athlete Entry Form**

Named Entries must be completed on the official FINA Named Athlete Entry Form. This form must be received by the Russian Swimming Federation no later than October 2, 2013.

### **Protocol**

Costume Protocol - Swimwear worn shall be according to FINA by-laws BL7 and BL8.

### **MANAGERS/REPRESENTATIVES MEETING**

A Managers/Representatives meeting will be held on October 11, 2013 **at 5:00 pm**. One representative from each National Federation/Club must attend this meeting. This will be the last opportunity to make entry changes for duly entered National Teams and Clubs.

- Scratches for the first session of heats are due by the close of business of the managers/representatives meeting.
- Scratches for the second session of heats are due one (1) hour prior to the start of finals the first evening.
- DNS will be fined according to FINA Rules.

### **COMPETITION INFORMATION**

The FINA Swimming World Cup 2013 – Moscow, Russia meet will be held in a ten (10) lane, 25 metre competition pool. The competition will consist of the following individual events for both Men and Women:

- Freestyle 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m (W only), 1500m (M only)
- Backstroke 50m, 100m, 200m
- Breaststroke 50m, 100m, 200m
- Butterfly 50m, 100m, 200m

- Individual Medley 100m, 200m, 400m

Please note that the 400m Medley, 800m Freestyle, and 1500m Freestyle will be seeded and swum as timed finals. Slow heats will be swum during heats sessions, and the fastest heat swum during finals. However, the fastest heats of 400m and 800m, 1500m Freestyle will be swum before the start of the TV signal.

For the 2013 edition of the Series, the following events shall be included in the competition programme of the Series at each meet:

- Day 1: 4 x 50m Medley Mixed
- Day 2: 4 x 50m Freestyle Mixed

These events will take place as the last event on each day.

The rules for the Mixed Relays are the same as for gender relays except that the Mixed Relays must consist of 2 (two) Male and 2 (two) Female swimmers. The starting order of the swimmers is decided by each team (FINA rules BL9.3.6.7, BL9.3.6.8, SW10.10, SW10.11, SW10.12, SW10.13).

The Relay Entry Form (provided by FINA) should as usual be handed in 1 (one) hour before the start of the competition for both heats and finals. With less than 8 (eight) teams entered there will be direct finals.

In addition to the above mentioned Competition Programme, simple awards ceremonies will be included at all events in the format of 4 races, 4 ceremonies with the exception of the first round of ceremonies. The 1<sup>st</sup> set of ceremonies includes 4 events (2 outside TV time and 2 in TV time). The 2<sup>nd</sup> set of ceremonies starts with 50m Breaststroke, the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of ceremonies starts with 50m Backstroke, the 4<sup>th</sup> set of ceremonies starts with 50m Freestyle.

All announcements, instructions, and commands during the event will be delivered in English.

## RULES

All events included for competition shall be conducted under the rules of FINA.

## PRIZE MONEY

### **Individual Event Prize Money**

The meet consists of 34 individual races. For each race:

-	Winner	USD \$ 1.500,-
-	Second	USD \$ 1.000,-
-	Third	USD \$ 500,-
	<b>Total</b>	<b>USD \$ 3.000,-</b>

The Russian Swimming Federation will provide a total prize pool of USD \$ 102.000,- for the Moscow event.

There is no prize money for the Mixed Relays events.

In the case of a tie, prize money shall be shared (e.g. If there are two winners, no second place prize will be awarded. The total of USD \$ 2.500,- will be shared equally between the two winners, each earning USD \$ 1.250,-).

If a swimmer does not come to the awards ceremony podium, he will not be entitled to any prize money. Additionally each swimmer coming to the awards ceremony podium needs to be properly dressed up; e. g. wearing their full team's tracksuit.

### **Overall Prize Money (World Cup Winners)**

There will be separate rankings for Men and Women and the distribution of the overall prize money will be as follows:

<b>Winner</b>	<b>USD \$ 100.000,-</b>
<b>Second</b>	<b>USD \$ 50.000,-</b>
<b>Third</b>	<b>USD \$ 30.000,-</b>
<b>Total</b>	<b>USD \$ 180.000,-</b>

### **World Record Bonus**

- A payment of USD \$ 10.000,- is made for each new World Record set at an Event but limited to a maximum pot of USD \$ 50.000,-.
- If more World Records than the agreed maximum pot can cover are set, all World Record holders will then receive an equal share of the overall amount, rather than the USD10'000 per World Record.

- Such payment will be symbolically made with a presentation cheque to be handed out at the awards ceremony.
- If in one same race (heat or final) two (2) or more swimmers better the World Record, only the winner of that race will receive the bonus.
- World Records achieved at a split will not be considered for this bonus (e.g.: World Record for a 50m achieved at the 50m Split of a 100m race). Any World Record bonuses will be paid for performances over the actual competition distance. No bonus is due if a World Record is equalled.

**Cluster Prize Money (overall of USD 812'000)**

This additional prize money will be equally shared between the first 6 ranked men and first 6 ranked women at each cluster.

Cluster 1 (Eindhoven, August 7-8; Berlin, August 10-11): USD 200'000.

Cluster 2 (Moscow, October 12-13; Dubai, October 17-18; Doha, October 20-21): USD 306'000

Cluster 3 (Singapore, November 5-6; Tokyo, November 9-10; Beijing, November 13-14): USD 306'000

### **SCORING SYSTEM**

The Information concerning the scoring system is:

#### **By Meet:**

- Three best performances (according to the FINA Points Table), with the following score:**

Best performance: 24 points

2<sup>nd</sup> best performance: 18 points

3<sup>rd</sup> best performance: 12 points

- In case of tie, the second best performance is taken into account (as per the present rules)

- Medallists in all individual events, with the following score:**

Gold medal: 12 points

Silver medal: 9 points

Bronze medal: 6 points

- Bonus for World Record performance: 20 points**

#### **By Cluster:**

- The ranking will be established by adding all the Performance, Ranking (medallist) and WR points**

- In case of tie with one of the swimmer having a WR performance: first is the swimmer with WR performance.
- In case of tie with swimmers having WR performance: first is the swimmer with best WR performance (in accordance to the FINA Points Table).
- In case of tie with Performance and Ranking points: first is the swimmer with the higher number of Ranking points.
- In case of tie with Ranking points: first is the swimmer with the higher number of Ranking points in any of the cluster's leg.

**Overall:**

**1. Sum all the Cluster Points**

- In case of tie, first is the swimmer with the best position in any of the clusters.

**VISA REQUIREMENTS**

If you decide to attend the FINA/ARENA Swimming World Cup in Moscow, your delegation may be required to show a visa upon entering Russia. For further information re visa requirements contact the Russian Federation Embassy in your country.

Your first step before applying to the Russian Consulate or Russian Embassy in your country is to send to the Organising Committee by e-mail or by fax the following information re each person to obtain visa (each member of your delegation) **not later than 14 days before enter to Russia:**

1. Dates of arrival and departure
2. City and country, where the visa will be picked up
3. Participant's (person's) names
4. Date of birth
5. Passport number
6. Expire date
7. Function (athlete, coach, manager, accompanying person, FINA official etc)
8. Photocopy of the passports

The Organising Committee will give all the documents to our Ministry of Foreign Affairs for permission. After that, the Organising Committee receives notification and registration number of your visa from our Ministry. We inform you of it by the invitation letter and only after that you shall go to the Russian Consulate with the documents including: invitation letter, valid passport, visa application, photos.

**ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS**

The Russian Swimming Federation will offer accommodation to all participating athletes and team officials of that event as per FINA / Swimming World Cup rules & regulations (2011-2013).

The Officials hotels for the FINA/ Swimming World Cup – Moscow, Russia are the Holiday Inn Sushevsky Hotel and Cosmos Hotel.

#### **Accommodation / Cancellation Fee**

Accommodation must be fully prepaid before **September 21, 2013** otherwise we cannot guarantee your accommodation.

Federations having made reservations of Hotel rooms may cancel or vary wholly or partially up to September 21, 2013.

After the above-mentioned date reservations will be the responsibility of each National Federation.

“NO SHOWS” will be fully charged for accommodation and food in full volume for the whole period of reservation. Cancellation without charge must be notified to OC Office latest September 21, 2013. After September 21, 2013 any cancellations will be also charged in full volume.
